



## **NOTICE OF DECISIONS TO BE MADE BY THE EXECUTIVE IN PRIVATE ON 10 OCTOBER 2019**

### **MADE UNDER THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012**

Under the Regulations, local authorities are required to publish a Notice of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. Where the date by which the meeting must be held makes compliance impractical, the meeting may only be held in private where agreement has been obtained from the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. In the event the Chairman of the Committee is unable to act, agreement must be obtained from the Mayor.

This Notice sets out those decisions to be taken in private at the meeting of the Executive on **10 October 2019** which have not been included on previously published statutory notices, in line with the Regulations effective from 10 September 2012. In accordance with the Regulations, the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been consulted and has agreed for the items to be considered in private at the meeting.

<b>Reason for decision being made in private</b>	Not for publication by virtue of paragraph 3 (Information relating to any individual) of Part 1 of Schedule 12A (L.G.A.1972).
<b>Reasons why the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.</b>	A decision on the item is required to be made before the next meeting of the Executive on 21 November 2019.
