



NOTICE OF URGENT DECISIONS TO BE MADE BY THE EXECUTIVE IN PRIVATE ON 10 OCTOBER 2019

MADE UNDER THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

It has not been possible to include the following item on a previously published Notice as the need for the determination was unknown at the time of publication. The decision cannot be reasonably be deferred to a later meeting due to the need for the other party to determine the matter before the end of October 2019.

KEY DECISIONS TO BE MADE BY THE EXECUTIVE IN PRIVATE AS A MATTER OF URGENCY

Under the Regulations, local authorities are required to publish a Notice of their intention to hold a meeting of the Executive in private at least 28 clear days before the meeting. In the event a key decision is to be taken as a matter of urgency by the Executive and does not therefore comply with regulations 9 or 12 of the 2012 Regulations, agreement must first be obtained from the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee. In the event the Chairman of the Committee is unable to act, agreement must be obtained from the Mayor.

This Notice sets out the key decision to be taken in private by the Executive on **10 October 2019** as a matter of urgency together with the reason why the decision is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred. In accordance with Regulation 11, the Chairman of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee has been consulted and has agreed for the item to be considered as a matter of urgency.
