

URGENT BUSINESS

Executive Summary

The Mayor has indicated that she will, under Section 100B(4) of the Local Government Act 1972, deal with the following matters as Urgent Business at tonight's Council meeting. In each case, the urgency results from the need to make the appointments now (to ensure that the Council can continue to conduct its business in an efficient manner).

1. Planning Committee

1.1 Councillor Nancy Martin is a member of the Planning Committee. Councillor Martin is currently on maternity leave, so is unable to attend the next 3/4 Planning Committee meetings. It is proposed that Councillor Chitra Rana be appointed a substitute member of the Planning Committee for the remainder of the 2020/21 Municipal Year.

2. Election of Leader of the Council

2.1 Under item 10 of tonight's agenda, the Leader of the Council will be making a statement. In the event that the Leader resigns from his position as Leader of the Council, there will (at that time) be an election of a new Leader of the Council, followed by a statement from that Leader. Group Leaders will also have the opportunity to make a statement.
